**Competitors must read the following Race responsibilities and then read and sign the Declaration.**

### **Race responsibilities**

1. A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.
2. It is for the boat skipper to decide whether she is fit to sail in the conditions in which she finds herself. By launching or going to sea, the boat skipper confirms that she is fit for those conditions and her crew is competent to sail in them.
3. The boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of £2,000,000.
4. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, patrol boats and beach masters.
5. By signing this entry form participants accept that they are responsible for themselves, their crew and their boats whether ashore or afloat.
6. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the boat skipper of any responsibilities.
